BE IT ENACTED BY THE YOUTH GOVERNMENT FOR THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, that this act may be cited as the Technology Improvement Act.

Section 1: The District of Columbia Department of Education invest in increasing technology for all high school students at public and public charter high schools.

Section 2: The State Superintendent of Education shall write grants and budget appropriate funds to allow for enough computers for at least 1/3 or the student population at each high school. Computers should be available for use before, during and after school. The computers should also be made available for parents of the students on certain evenings and weekends.

Section 3: The State Superintendent of Education will release this plan as soon as possible. It is important for all students to have daily contact with computers in order to

be successful in today's world. The Department of Education should solicit support from the business community of Washington, DC for this proposal, especially the technology community.

Financial Impact: The project is estimated to cost approximately \$75,000,000,000. The DC government shall earmark half of the cost, with the plan of finding support for the remaining half through donations. The portion coming from the budget shall be from the money saved by closing area schools during the 2007-2008 school year.

Effective Date: This act shall take effect on as soon as it receives approval by the Youth Mayor and City Council.
